A website which aims to help refugees across Yorkshire become better integrated members of their communities has won top Government recognition.

The Refugee Access website has been awarded the maximum five stars by the Home Office and is now being held up as an example for other across the country to follow.

The multilingual website, established by the Yorkshire and Humberside Consortium for Asylum Seekers and Refugees, helps refugees find information about learning to speak English and other vital skills they will need, as well as finding gainful employment in the region, and events.
