

## **Drugscope toolkit's multilingual info**

A Drug prevention toolkit aimed at members of UK ethnic community groups was launched last week by charity DrugScope. The toolkit was devised by the charity in partnership with the government's anti-drugs strategy for England and Wales called Frank. The kit seeks to bolster the armoury of information available to professionals, community groups, as well as drug users and their families. It includes 11 leaflets, audio tapes and a CD-Rom which gives drugs information in English as well as Arabic, Bengali, Cantonese, French, Gujarti, Punjabi, Somali, Urdu, Farsi, Kurdish (Kumanji) and Turkish. It covers areas including the law, cocaine and crack.
