

Let's Move On: Black and minority ethnic older people's views on research findings

Race Equality Unit

The Race Equality Unit carried out a series of consultations with black and minority ethnic older people, which revealed that some wanted to see more action, not necessarily more research, into their needs; other believed that some of the research they'd been involved in wasn't very relevant, or simply repeated earlier research.

This study re-affirms that BME older people felt that many mainstream services still did not meet their needs and again emphasised that culturally-appropriate community or voluntary groups' services often met their needs best.
