

## **The Multicultural Centre in Leeds is now Open**

With the aim of bringing together all those organisations and individuals who want to extend their work across the many different communities in Leeds, the new Multicultural Centre has been opened for organisations that work with people with learning disabilities. The Centre will be a focus for consultation, training and other activities, which help to develop better services and opportunities for people with learning difficulties and disabilities from minority communities.

The Multicultural Centre not only works with Leeds communities but also aims to build regional and national links. The project has been supported by the Big Lottery Fund.

The rooms have been fully refurbished and will be available from September. Rooms on the ground floor all have good access and are available to view by prior arrangement.

An advisory group voice their opinion regarding the organisation and activities of the Centre and will decide on a name along with other matters.

The Centre is a base for:

**SKIN DEEP** – a Leeds based advocacy organisation which campaigns for Black and Asian people with learning difficulties and disabilities.

**ROOTS** – a social firm of African Caribbean people with learning disabilities who offer training and consultancy.

**ASIAN SOCIAL FIRM** – a new social firm for Asian people with learning difficulties and disabilities who will be offering training and consultancy from next year.
