WEDHS Honoured at 2007 Diversity Awards

At the 2007 Diversity Awards, held at the National Assembly for Wales Sennedd building last Friday, 7th September, the Wales Equality and Diversity in Health and Social Care Research Support Service (WEDHS) was honoured with the 'Educational Body Award'.
